

CHRIST IN ALL SCRIPTURES: From Genesis to Revelation and everything in between God and his pursuit of a love relationship with man is the central focus and Jesus Christ is the answer. Christ was the plan from the beginning and as we search for Him we find Him in every book of the Bible. This summer we are taking a journey through all 66 books of the Bible to find Christ in all scriptures.

I encourage you to join us by reading through the verses selected from each book in order and come to know Christ as God's eternal plan of hope. In your small group, come together and discuss what you are learning about Jesus Christ and God's plan.

• **Acts** **Our Risen Lord (1:3)**

After his suffering, he presented himself to them and gave many convincing proofs that he was alive. He appeared to them over a period of forty days and spoke about the kingdom of God.

What does this passage teach you about Christ?

• **Romans** **The Promise Fulfilled (1:2-4)**

The gospel he promised beforehand through his prophets in the Holy Scriptures regarding his Son, who as to his earthly life was a descendant of David, and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord.

What does this passage teach you about Christ?

• **I Corinthians** **The Wisdom of God (1:30)**

It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God—that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption.

What does this passage teach you about Christ?



• **II Corinthians** **Our Sufficient Grace (12:9-10)**

But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ’s power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ’s sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

What does this passage teach you about Christ?

• **Galatians** **The Life In Me (2:20)**

I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

What does this passage teach you about Christ?

• **Ephesians** **Our Exalted Head (1:22)**

And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church.

What does this passage teach you about Christ?

Group Discussion Questions:

- Read through the passages for this week. List the words that describe Jesus in these passages.
- Now share how that affects you and how it helps you in your daily life.
- If you had the opportunity to share your faith in Jesus how could these passages help you? What might you share?
