• **Titus** **Our Great God (2:13)**

While we wait for the blessed hope—the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ,

What does this passage teach you about Christ?

• **Philemon** **Giver of Every Good Thing (6)**

I pray that your partnership with us in the faith may be effective in deepening your understanding of every good thing we share for the sake of Christ.

What does this passage teach you about Christ?

• **Hebrews** **The Radiance of God's Glory (1:3)**

The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven.

What does this passage teach you about Christ?

• **James** **The One Who Lifts Me Up (4:10)**

Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up.

What does this passage teach you about Christ?

• **I Peter** **Our Rock (2:6)**

For in Scripture it says:

“See, I lay a stone in Zion,
a chosen and precious cornerstone,
and the one who trusts in him
will never be put to shame.”

What does this passage teach you about Christ?

• **II Peter** **Our Precious Promise (1:4)**

Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature, having escaped the corruption in the world caused by evil desires.

What does this passage teach you about Christ?

- What about Hebrews 1:3. What description of Jesus do you get from this passage?
- How would these two passages, along with countless others argue the fact the Jesus is God?
