Evergreen Valley Christian School will seek to develop each child:

**Socially, Emotionally, and Morally;**

***To create a confident, concerned, and principled child.***

EVCS will use:

Positive Practice Behavioral Techniques

Socio-drama and role playing to reinforce social learning and decision making

**Intellectually;**

***To ensure your child is learning at an academically appropriate level.***

Through participation in:

Small group hands-on exploration time, such as with learning stations

Small group teacher-led instruction, where children are grouped according to developmental and academic appropriateness

Whole group learning, such as in circle time and enrichment programs

By using these familiar frameworks for learning, we can also address principle areas of school readiness such as listening, following directions, and asking for help.

**Physically;**

***To create a strong and healthy child, who is thriving.***

Through activities geared towards the careful progress of each child's:

Fine motor skills (such as drawing, small object manipulation, and beginning writing)

Gross motor skills (such as climbing, pushing/pulling, kicking, and running)

Small and large group play skills (including turn-taking and being a good sport)

**Spiritually;**

***To ensure that each child understands that they are a uniquely created being, designed for the purpose of glorifying our creator, God, with their lives.***

EVCS will utilize Biblical integration across the scope of the curriculum, rather than mere Biblical reference. Themes and activities will be thoughtfully presented from a Biblical worldview. We understand that the worldview of the teacher, inasmuch as he is effective, directly affects the worldview of the student, and we commit to staffing our school with those who share our philosophy, and hold an eternal perspective.
